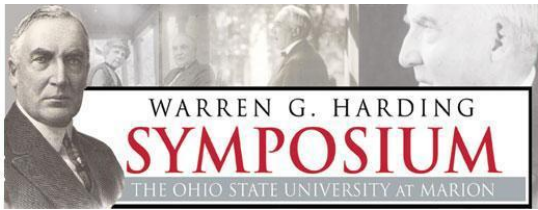
## ***The Man, the Myth, and the Legacy*** ***July 23-24, 2010***
